Range Use Checklist

- Display 'Range Active' sign at top of Silent Witness Road.
- Main gate may be left up or lowered behind you.
- Mix up lock combination so non-members cannot read it.
- Gate should remain unlocked for quicker exit in case of emergency.
- Fill out log book entry in Clubhouse.
- Fill out and submit guest form and fee in Clubhouse as if you have guests shooting.
- Display Membership card while using the range.
- Raise the Red "Range Active" Flag located on the right side of the shooting platform.

Shooting is only permitted on Ranges A (100 meter) & D (trap range)!
No firearms permitted on Archery (upper) Range!

- Range use is based on a first come/first serve basis unless there is a scheduled event.
 - Multiple users can use the range simultaneously provided shooting is done from the same distance and a Range Safety Officer is declared to ensure safe operations.
 - SAFETY IS PARAMOUNT, unload and rack or case all firearms before range is declared clear!**
 - SAFETY IS PARAMOUNT, no handling of firearms while someone is downrange!**
 - Ensure all rounds fired will impact on the backstop and not on the range floor/left or right/or above the backstop.
 - When shooting on Range A, you can move closer to the backstop. Shooting is not required to be done from the shooting platform.
 - Place garbage in garbage cans, spent brass casings in brass containers, misfires in misfire bucket.

- When leaving the Range
 - ⇒ Clean up your mess and stow any gear used.
 - ⇒ Lower flag.
 - ⇒ Turn off anything you had turned on.
 - ⇒ Lock Clubhouse.
 - ⇒ Lock up Gate on road.
 - ⇒ Return sign at top of Silent Witness Road to 'Range is Closed'.
